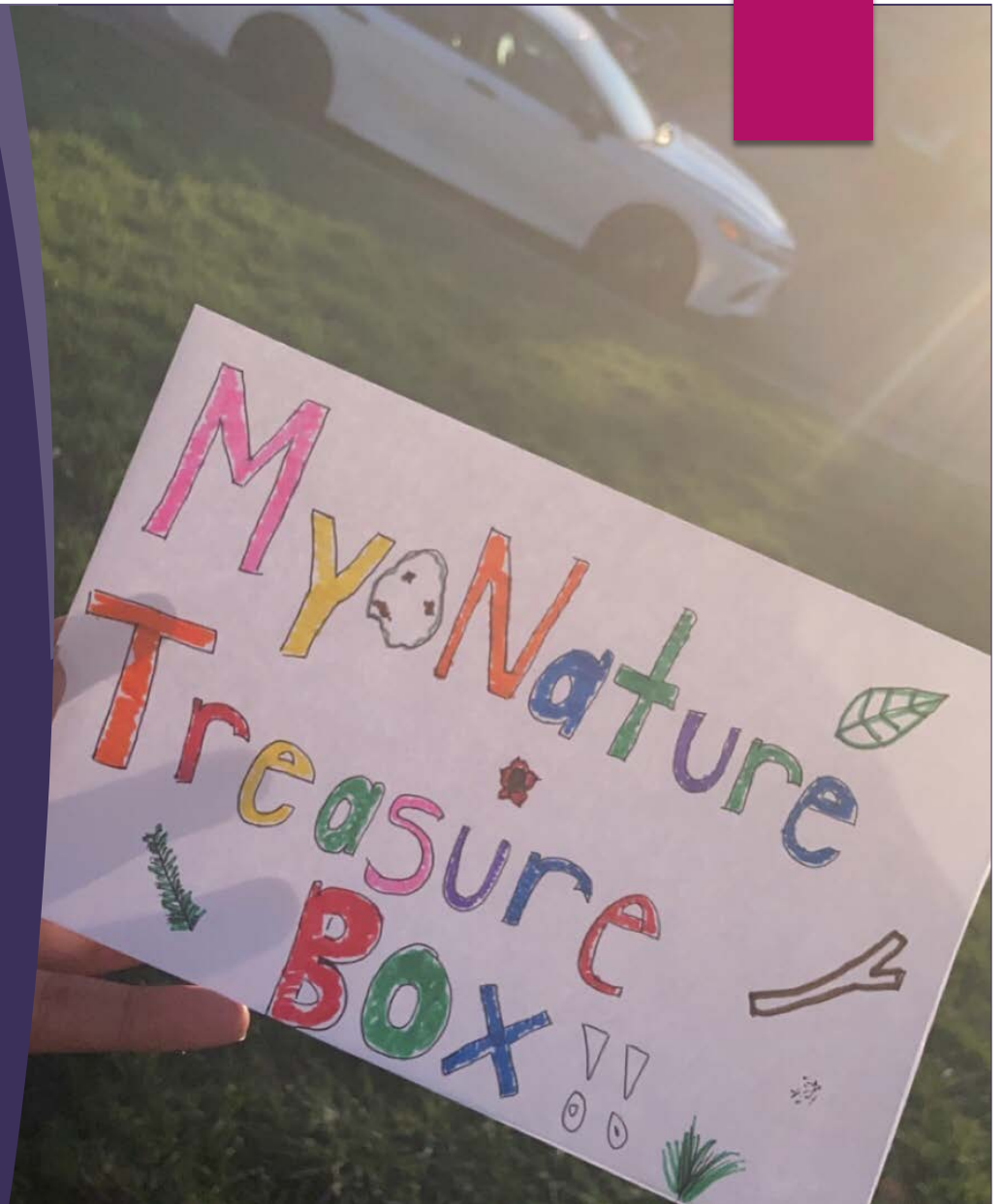


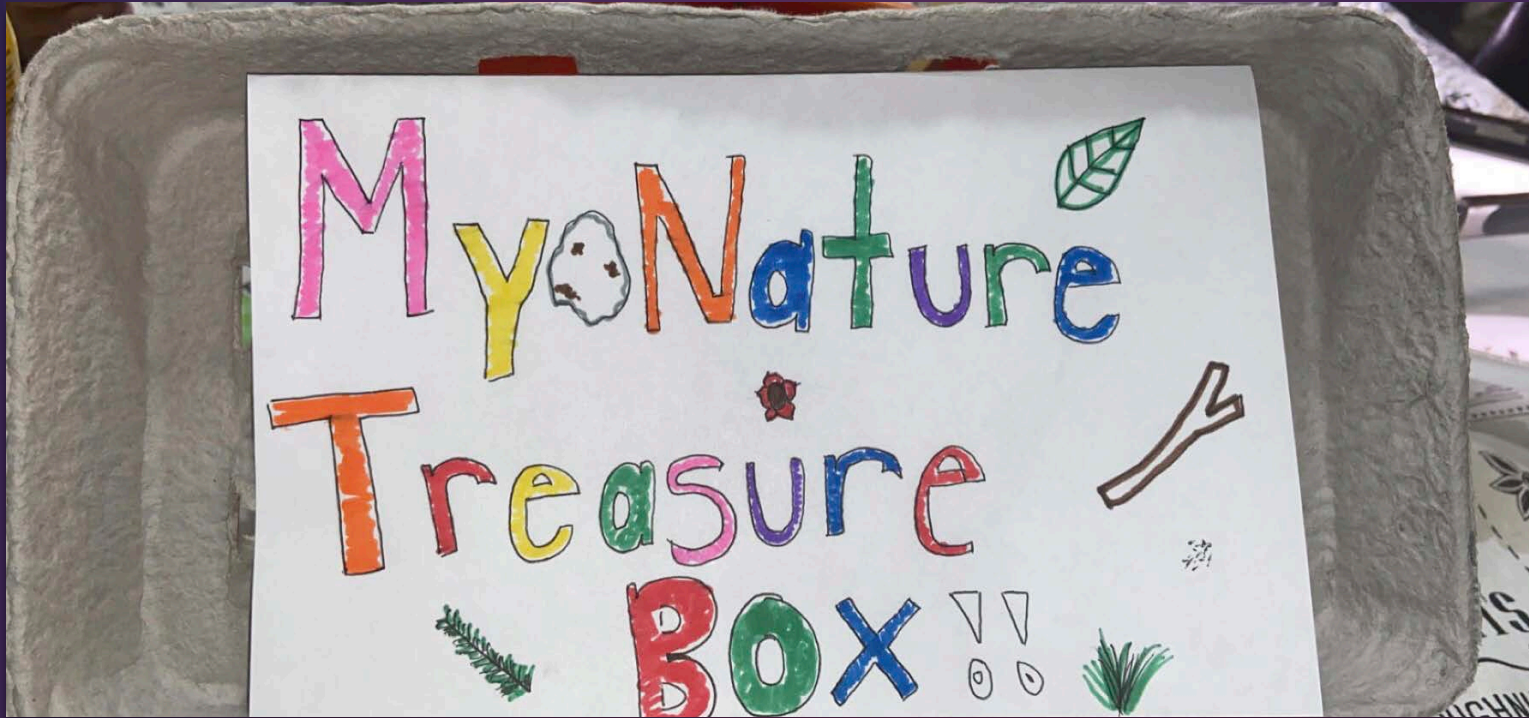
Materials

- ▶ Egg carton (preferably 12 ct but any size works)
- ▶ Backyard or open space where you can search for your things
- ▶ Gloves (you will be touching some dirty stuff)

Step 1- Make a cute sign for your egg carton/scanner treasure box

- ▶ This is an example of mine
- ▶ Be as creative and colorful as you want





Step 2: Glue or tape your sign to the inside of the carton

If your sign is smaller that is okay, you can decorate your carton if you would like.

Step 3: Look at your list and determine a setting

- ▶ I chose my front yard because I thought it would be a place where I could find more things.
- ▶ The list is as follows:
 - ▶ A rock
 - ▶ A flower
 - ▶ Grass
 - ▶ A green leaf
 - ▶ Dandelion
 - ▶ Dirt
 - ▶ A stick
 - ▶ Pine Needles
 - ▶ Piece of Bark
 - ▶ A Feather
 - ▶ Something you consider a treasure
 - ▶ Something you think is beautiful
